JUST FERTILIZING THE LAWN.

You use chemical fertilizer on your lawn. Sprinklers run too long, or it rains. The sprinkler runoff and rainfal wash excess fertilizer into the storm drains where it flows directly into our lakes, streams and creeks. This causes algae to grow, which uses up oxygen that fish need to survive. Instead, don't apply fertilizer before it rains. Check your sprinkler settings and always follow the label instructions.
